PAUMCS members are actively involved in the life and ministry of United Methodist Churches. We provide support in a variety of office environments...local churches, district offices, extension ministries, agencies and Annual Conferences. We are open to secretaries, administrative assistants, office managers, financial secretaries and any other administrative professionals...employees, volunteers, or retired persons who maintain their PAUMCS certification. GCFA offers an on-line certification class and an advance certification class. Certification requires continuing education credits to maintain, which are offered in a variety of areas and avenues. The Georgia Chapter of PAUMCS, which includes the North and South Georgia Conferences, publishes an e-newsletter and has a networking "e-news" for questions and answers to allow administrative professionals to stay connected. We also stay connected through social media outlets, posting information on training in the North and South GA Conferences and other trainings as related to our ministries, as well as employment opportunities within the United Methodist Church. The Georgia Chapter holds a conference each year, rotated between North and South Georgia, which allows members to recharge, network, and grow. ## WHO WE ARE

At the 2017 Annual Business Meeting of the National PAUMCS Annual Conference in Chicago, the body approved a name change for the organization changing the name from Professional Association of United Methodist Church Secretaries to Professional Administrators of the United Methodist Connectional Structure. This change had been discussed for many years, but has finally become a reality. The main purpose behind the name change is an effort to be more inclusive and open up membership to a wider range of employees. While the term “secretary” can be considered misleading and not representative of many of our members, the new name should encompass a much broader base.

The PAUMCS organization has always been open to secretaries, administrative assistants, office managers, financial secretaries and any other administrative professionals at United Methodist Churches, extension ministries, agencies or Annual Conferences and to any retired persons who maintain their PAUMCS certification. The purpose of the organization is to provide members a supportive base for unity and fellowship and to promote individual growth, professional development, continuing education and spiritual enrichment. PAUMCS was first organized in 1982 and falls under the authority of the General Council on Finance and Administration (GCFA) of The United Methodist Church.

## RENEWED IN OUR CALLING

Hello Friends! I pray you experienced a Lenten season filled with renewal, and growth in your spiritual walk.

2019 National Conference was held at sea on the Royal Caribbean Independence of the Seas, and in Cozumel, Mexico. What an experience! We were led in sessions by Rev. Mike Slaughter, his wife Carolyn, and his executive assistant Catherine Crowell. We toured the Ciudad de Angeles orphanage in Cozumel and saw the wonderful way that organization operates. The children live in homes, with house parents, are given chores and responsibilities, in addition to attending school. Once they reach the age of 18, they are given the opportunity to stay on the campus in dormitories while attending college. The goal is when they reach adulthood, they will stay in the local community and make a difference. The orphanage is funded entirely with donations, and no new facilities are built until money is in hand! The most recent buildings completed are the office and laundry facilities. It is set in a beautiful area giving the children an opportunity to grow and flourish! The tour was a wonderful blessing. Rev. Slaughter challenged us with the question "How do I continue a life that is an excellent offering to God?"...with **DRIVE** ~ Devotion to God, Readiness for lifelong learning, Investing in relationships,

Visioning for the future, Eating and Exercising for life. He also shared that Moses' adult life was broken into 40-year stages...first 40 were *God Bless Me*, second 40 were *God Save Me*, and the third 40 were *God Guide Me* (*give me direction*), and how that applies to our lives and our walk with Christ. Not that we will live to be 120+, but the lessons still apply!

Carolyn Slaughter shared her testimony, showing that even people who think have it all, struggle with heartache and challenges...marital, work, family.

Catherine Crowell shared her ministry experiences and the difference between a secretary and an assistant. A secretary does traditional office work; an assistant anticipates the needs of their ministry partners, is proactive in getting things done, and plans accordingly. Assistants are an "invaluable blessing" for the many hats we wear, the many jobs we do, and the smile that is always on our faces!

Soooo...upon returning to the "real" world, I have a renewed view of who I am and what my ministry is all about. I have always gotten the job done, going above what is expected, but now I am more willing to step out and be that "invaluable blessing" God intends me to be!
